

Frontload & Compactor Container Materials Reference Guide

The items listed below **DON'T** belong in your containers.



NO Batteries

WHY NOT: They can cause fires, endanger workers and harm the environment.

INSTEAD: Find your best disposal option at earth911.com. Many landfills have a local drop off, contact for disposal options.



NO Dangerous Waste (Liquid, Hazardous or Sludges)

WHY NOT: They can cause fires, endanger workers and harm the environment.

INSTEAD: Contact your local drop off center, solid waste district, or landfill for disposal options.



NO Tires

WHY NOT: Need to be recycled properly and aren't accepted in single stream recycling.

INSTEAD: Contact your local drop off center or our customer care center for disposal options.



NO Appliances or Scrap Metal

WHY NOT: They can cause fires, endanger workers, harm the environment, and damage sorting equipment.

INSTEAD: Contact your local drop off center or HVAC program for disposal options. You can also see if there is a local scrap metal recycler that accepts these items.



NO Mattresses/ Box Springs

WHY NOT: Need to be disposed of properly and aren't accepted in single stream recycling.

INSTEAD: Contact your local drop off center or our customer care center for disposal options.



NO Yard Waste

WHY NOT: It diverts unnecessary volume to the landfill and impacts the recoverability of other items.

INSTEAD: Contact your local drop off center or solid waste district for disposal options, or manage materials at home by composting.



NO Building Materials (C&D/Wood)

WHY NOT: Need to be disposed of properly and aren't accepted in single stream recycling.

INSTEAD: Contact your local drop off center or our customer care center for disposal options.



NO Ashes or Asbestos

WHY NOT: They can cause fires, endanger workers and harm the environment.

INSTEAD: Contact your local drop off center, solid waste district, or landfill for disposal options.



NO Electronics

WHY NOT: They get broken during sorting, are unsafe, and can cause fires.

INSTEAD: Contact local solid waste district or landfill for recycling options.



NO Items With Mercury

WHY NOT: They can endanger workers and harm the environment.

INSTEAD: Contact your local drop off center, solid waste district or visit terracycle.com for disposal options.
