

PREPARING FOR DUMPSTER DELIVERY

Steps to ensure a safe and efficient dumpster delivery



Step 1: Ensure the drop off area is clear

The driveway and surrounding area should be clear of cars and other items, including low hanging branches or wires. During winter, please ensure all snow and ice is clear – please salt or sand the area before arrival.



Step 2: Mark the delivery area

Use cones or tape to identify for the driver the ideal area to place the dumpster. You can provide 2x8 boards as an extra layer of protection for your driveway if you have concerns. For a successful delivery we need at least 3' of clearance around each side, 22' of height clearance, and 34' in a straight line from delivery location. You can also send a photo of the location if any questions!



Step 3: Know before you throw

Ensure you know the types of material that can and cannot be thrown into the dumpster, check your waiver and container loading instructions for your area's restricted materials. Call us with any questions!



Step 4: Plan for dumpster pickup

The container must not be overloaded with any materials protruding over the top, and the doors should be fully closed and free of obstructions for easy removal. If it rains or snows, tarp the container to avoid extra weight charges but remove the tarp before the driver arrives. During winter, ensure the area in front of and around the dumpster is clear of snow and ice, and apply salt or sand as needed before the driver's arrival.

Always check your waiver and loading instructions for local restrictions! Generally not accepted in any area: Car batteries, electronic waste, hazardous materials, items containing mercury, items containing freon, tires, pressurized items, or yard waste
