

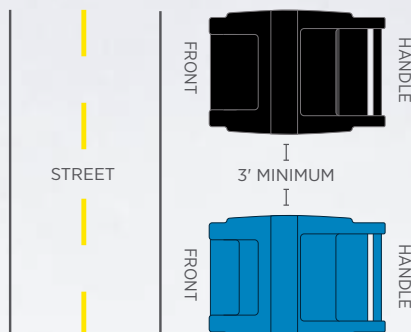


CURBSIDE CONTAINER PLACEMENT GUIDE

Place containers at the curb the night before pickup day.

PROPER CONTAINER PLACEMENT

Put containers on a hard, level surface clear of obstructions such as snow, landscaping, mailboxes, and utility poles. Do not block the sidewalk.



CONTAINER DON'TS



Containers must remain upright and forward facing for pickup



Keep all materials inside the container with the lid closed



Do not place containers back to back



Keep container clear of all obstructions

? FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How does recycling work?

Casella makes recycling simple with single stream collection. This means you can place paper, cardboard, plastic, glass, and metal cans together in one bin—no sorting required. At our facilities, these materials are separated by type for proper processing.

Reminder: Trash and non-recyclable items do not belong in your recycling bin.

Can I put trash in my recycling bin?

No. Only recyclables belong in your recycling bin. Items that are not recyclable should go in the trash—except for medical or hazardous waste, which requires special handling.

How should I prepare recyclables?

Recyclables should be empty and free of excess food residue—a quick rinse is helpful but perfection isn't required. Corrugated cardboard boxes should be flattened and cut down to pieces no larger than 2' for easier handling.

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RECYCLING

Toss **ONLY** unbagged, loose recyclable items listed below into your recycling bin

CARDBOARD/PAPER



Cardboard & Boxboard
(Clean & dry)



Junk Mail, Periodicals, Office Paper & Paper Cups
(Paper bags & cups, envelopes, & catalogs)

PLASTIC



Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Tubs, & Lids
(Empty kitchen, laundry & bath containers, & clamshell packaging)

METAL



Aluminum & Steel Cans
(Clean foil & empty food or beverage cans)

GLASS



Glass Bottles & Jars
(Empty food & drink containers only)

REMEMBER TO RECYCLE BETTER!

- ✓ No items smaller than 2" in size
- ✓ All containers are empty, rinsed, & dry
- ✓ Cardboard is flattened & broken down
- ✓ There are NO items from the **NOT ACCEPTED** list in the recycling bin

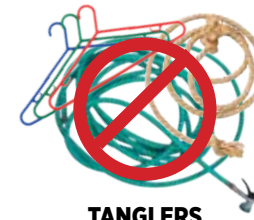
